

Castration (Neuter) Instructions!

The surgery that your pet has undergone today consists of putting him under anesthesia and removing the testicles. Your dog can still breed for the next 21 days so keep him away from any females to avoid unwanted pregnancy. The scrotal sac may swell up and have some bruising, this is normal but anything in excess should be reported to the doctor. Your dog has internal sutures and external sutures or glue. It is important that he rests for the next 14 days, he is not allowed to lick at the incision site nor should any of your additional pets be able to do so. No jumping! A pain injection was administered at the time of surgery and will last 24 hours. Additional pain medication and antibiotics are recommended for the comfort and health of your dog, these are optional. You should Leash walk and cage confine your dog for the next 14 days to for optimal healing. No food or water until the morning after surgery. Please call us with any questions you may have.
